

Strengthening Agricultural Extension Activities under Farmer FIRST Programme

Two training session cum farmer-scientist interaction meet was organized on 13.10.17 under Farmer FIRST Programme, Participatory Technology Application and Multi-stakeholder Convergence for Market led Agripreneurship and Sustainable Rural Livelihood in village Katesara, Palwal Haryana.
