Brainstorming workshop on Carbon credits for small-holder farms: Approaches and framework for implementation was organized Division of Environmental Sciences, ICAR-Indian Agricultural Research Institute, New Delhi on 28th April,2025 to derive the Roadmap for Carbon Credits to Small Holder farmers.

Dr Ch Srinivasa Rao, Director ICAR-IARI has emphasized on the importance of developing robust methods for carbon credit monitoring and reporting. He emphasized on identification of technological baskets as well as landscape level interventions suitable for earning carbon credits top farming community in addition to life cycle assessment of agroforestry.
