About the Division

The ICAR-Indian Agricultural Research Institute (IARI) is the country's premier institution for agricultural research, education and extension. The Division of Agricultural Economics, a constituent of School of Social Sciences of IARI, was established in 1960. The mandate of the Division is to conduct research in frontier areas and serve as a centre for academic excellence in post-graduate education. Since its inception, the Division has been making contributions in basic and applied research with significant implications for agricultural policy. Since 1995, it is functioning as an ICAR Centre of Advanced Studies in Agricultural Economics with capacity strengthening for agricultural economics and policy research in the National Agricultural Research System.

Training Program

The Division of Agricultural Economics, under the auspices of CAFT, organizes training programs every year. So far 30 training programs, covering a wide array of topics under economics, econometrics and advances in agricultural policy research have been conducted. This year the Division has proposed to conduct a 21 days training program on the topic **“Technological and Policy Options for Enhancing Farmers' Income”**. Recently, Government of India has expressed its desire to double farmers' income by 2022. This calls for harnessing the synergy between informed policy interventions and agricultural technologies. In this context, it is topical to have a training programme on technological and policy options to enhance farmers' income. The training will focus on various technological, institutional and policy options to enhance farm income along with quantification of their impact. It will also provide an opportunity to the faculties and researchers in the field of Social Sciences of National Agricultural Research System to get the benefit from national and international experts working in the area.

Participants

Faculty and researchers in agricultural economics/ social sciences of SAUs, ICAR Institutes and other public institutes engaged in agricultural research shall apply for the training program. Around 20 participants will be selected.

Methodology

The training program will include lectures from specialists, computer-oriented problem-solving sessions and case studies. There will be balanced emphasis on the theory and application. The participants are encouraged to bring information on technology developed by their institute for case studies.

Eligibility

The candidate must possess a masters' degree in agricultural economics or related social sciences with at least five years teaching or research experience and should be working not below the rank of a scientist or assistant professor. Preference will be given to the candidates having some knowledge and job responsibility in the area related to the training.

Application for the program

Candidates desirous of participating in the course and fulfilling the eligibility conditions shall apply through proper channel in the given proforma. The participants should submit their applications only through online using CBP vortal (<http://iasri.res.in/cbp/>) or under the link Capacity Building Program at <http://icar.org.in>. After filling the online application, take a print out and get it approved by the competent authority of the organization. Upload the scanned copy of application through CBP vortal. The last date for uploading of complete application (proper channel) at CBP vortal is **25-07-2017**. Selected candidates will be informed at least one month prior to the start of the training program. T.A. to the participants will be paid as per their entitlement for the class of travel restricted to the maximum of AC II tier fare by the shortest route. Participants are required to produce tickets in support of their claim. CAFT will bear lodging and boarding expenses of all the participants as per ICAR rules.
