The themes of the course are ICT initiatives, upscaling and outscaling of farm innovations, market-led extension, innovations in extension methods, approaches, extension reforms of Ministry, video production, extension approaches of banking sector, producer company, private extension, entrepreneurship, etc.

Who can Apply?

The candidates should possess Master's Degree in Agriculture and allied subjects and should be working in the rank of Assistant Professor or equivalent in the concerned subject under SAUs/ICAR Institutes/KVKs.

Training Style

The Training style will be participative and action oriented. The emphasis will be on learning through experience rather than theories. Group Work, Group Discussion, Hands on experience etc. would be major interactive modes.

Course Faculty

The course will be conducted by Dr.J.P.Sharma, Dr.V.Lenin and Dr. R. Roy Burman, faculty of Division of Agricultural Extension, IARI, New Delhi. They will be supported by the other faculties of IARI and experts from ICAR, Ministries, Universities, NGOs, etc.

The duration of the CAFT course will be of twenty one days from September 3-23, 2014. The trainees are expected to arrive on September 2 and leave only after 5 PM on September 23 , 2014.
