IARI Celebrates Its Foundation Day

IARI celebrated its Foundation Day on 1st April 2019. It was a daylong celebration which was scheduled in 4 different sessions. On this occasion, Dr P.K. Mishra, Additional Principal Secretary to Prime Minister, laid the foundation stone of Agricultural Innovation Centre at IARI in gracious presence of Dr. T.
