1. Faculty Upgradation Scheme (FUS)

Admission of In-service Faculty Members of State Agricultural Universities (SAUs) under Faculty Upgradation Scheme (FUS)

Number of Seats: 10 for Ph.D. degree programme ONLY

- i. The Faculty Memebers applying under this scheme should be regular employees of the State Agricultural Universities (SAUs).
- ii. Not more than three candidates of any one State Agricultural University shall be admitted in any one year under this Scheme.
- iii. The words "Application for admission under Faculty Upgradation Scheme" should be clearly inscribed on the application and on the forwarding letter. The declaration as given at Annexure- I duly signed by the Vice-Chancellor or his/her nominee should be attached with the hard copy (print out) of online filled application form.

2. ICAR- In Service Scheme

Admission of Scientists working in ICAR Institutes under ICAR In service Scheme

Number of Seats: 10 for Ph.D. degree programme ONLY

- i. The candidates applying under this scheme should be Scientists working in ICAR Institutes.
- ii. The words "Application for admission under ICAR In Service Scheme" should be clearly inscribed on the application and on the forwarding letter. The declaration as given in Annexure-I duly signed by the Director of the concerned ICAR Institute should be attached with the hard copy (print out) of online filled application form.

3. Departmental (Scientific and Technical) Scheme

Admission under this scheme is for Scientific and Technical staff working at IARI, New Delhi and its Regional Stations/ICAR-IASRI, New Delhi/ICAR-NBPGR, New Delhi/ICAR-NIPB, New Delhi.

Priority VI : Wards of Ex-serviceman.

Priority VII : Wives of:

(i) Defence personnel disabled in action and boarded out from service.

(ii) Defence personnel disabled in service and boarded out with

disability attributable to military service.

(iii) Ex-serviceman and serving personnel who are in receipt of

Gallantry Awards.

Priority VIII : Wards of Serving Personnel.
Priority IX : Wives of Serving Personnel.
