INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES TAKING DEGREE IN PERSON IN THE 60th CONVOCATION TO BE HELD ON FEBRUARY 11, 2022

As the Convocation is solemn occasion which ought to be conducted with the fullest sense of discipline, dignity and decorum, every candidate receiving degree should maintain due solemnity throughout the ceremony. The following instructions may please be noted:

- 1. Full-dress rehearsal will be held at 15.45 hrs on February 10, 2022 (Thursday) in Shri. C. Subramaniam Auditorium, NASC Complex New Delhi. It is obligatory for every candidate who would be receiving the degree at the Convocation in person to be present at the rehearsal, failing which he/she shall not be admitted to the Convocation Function. The candidates will arrive early to collect their Khadi Jackets/Angvastra and occupy their seats by 14.00 hrs positively.
- 2. The Khadi Jackets/Angvastra will be delivered to the candidates on February 10, 2022 from 14.00 hrs at the reception counter of Shri. C. Subramaniam Auditorium, NASC Complex New Delhi.
- 3. The Convocation will be held on February 11, 2022 at 10.00 hrs (Friday). All candidates, receiving the degrees (in Person) in the Convocation should occupy their seats by 08.30 hrs. Candidates coming late will not be permitted entry in the Auditorium.
- 4. Each candidate taking degree in person has to appear in the prescribed costumes. All are required to pay due regard to formality and uniformity in their dress. Female students should appear in Cream Colour Silk Finish Saree (Blouse Cream with Red Border), Cream Colour Khadi Jacket and Angavastra. Male students should appear in White Colour Kurta with Pyjama (Churidaar), Cream Colour Khadi Jacket and Angavastra.
- 5. On the procession entering the Auditorium to the accompaniment of Convocation Music, all present will rise and remain standing until members of the Procession have taken their seats.
- 6. The candidates will remain standing, from the time their names are read out and the Director admits them to the respective degree.
- 7. After the Director has admitted the candidates to the respective degree the candidates then shall bow in acknowledgement and thereafter turning right walk to the dais from the left side of the dais to receive the degree from the Chief Guest. The candidates, will then climb down the dais from the other side and walk into the corridor in the Northern side of the Auditorium and stand in the corridor in the Southern side of the Auditorium till the last candidate in the particular row leaves to receive the degree. Thereafter, all the candidates belonging to that row will take their seats.
- 8. After the Director declares the Convocation closed, all present in the Auditorium will remain standing till the procession leaves the Auditorium.
 - Khadi Jackets and Angvastra will be available on hiring basis. Degree Recipients have to deposit Rs. 1500/- Cash in advance for hiring of Khadi Jackets and Angvastra.
