## Kisan Diwas Samaroh at ICAR-Indian Agricultural Research Institute, New Delhi

The Kisan Diwas was celebrated on 23rd December, 2023 at ICAR-Indian Agricultural Research Institute, New Delhi in its Pusa Krishi Haat ground to commemorate the birth anniversary of the Late Ch. Charan Singh, the fifth Prime Minister of India on a very important theme of Empowering FPOs through Technologies of Pusa Institute. The dignitaries and audience paid floral tribute to the Late Ch.
