#### **Indian Food Processing Sector**

- One of the largest industries in India, ranked 5<sup>th</sup> in terms of production, consumption, export and expected growth with 8.4 % average growth rate.
- Accounting for 32% of total food market, 14 % of manufacturing GDP, 13% of exports, 6% of total industrial investment and contributing 13.04% of employment generated.
- For the projected growth in the food processing industry, it is expected that the requirement of human resource would increase to about 17.8 million in 2022, an incremental human resource requirement of about 9.3 million persons till 2022.

Considering the immense job opportunities and diversified areas of work in the food processing sector and to bring awareness amongst youth, we are organizing this joint event.

Students of classes Xth to XIIth pursuing science are participating in the seminar from seven schools. The participation in the seminar is **Free of Cost** for all participants.
