

ICAR-IARI Students Excel in the Central Silk Board Scientist Selections

The ICAR-Indian Agricultural Research Institute (IARI) continued to demonstrate its academic excellence, with 36 of its students emerging successful in the Central Silk Board's nationwide selection process for 122 Scientist-B posts. IARI students have won more than 50% seats of the total seats in those subject categories they were eligible, excluding the subjects of Sericulture, Forestry and Animal Nutrition. Notably, students secured all available positions in Plant Genetic

Resources and Farm Machinery and Power Engineering. Students claimed 11 of the 17 posts in Entomology, 3 out of 4 posts in Soil Science, 4 out of 7 posts in Genetics and Plant Breeding, and 2 out of 3 positions in Agricultural Statistics.

IARI is 120-year-old India's top agricultural institution having ranked no. 1 in National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) and have a notable global presence. IARI continue to play its flagship role in driving food and nutritional security of the country as well as in human resource development across the globe.
